Job purpose

The Field Service Engineer II provides onsite and remote service and support to customers. S/he provides feedback and service knowledge to other Seno departments to drive improvements and share information. The Field Service Engineer II performs Service activities at clinical sites according to approved written instructions, and documents the activities performed.

Duties and responsibilities

- Troubleshoot, repair, and perform preventative maintenance on OA/US systems according to documented instructions
- Install and remove OA/US systems at clinical sites according to documented instructions
- Document activities, as required
- Coordinate service activities with site personnel, as needed
- Provide technical phone support to customers
- Communicate and help resolve technical issues in preparation for the install of an US/OA system
- Train others to perform servicing activities on OA/US systems
- Generate service instruction documentation
- Propose design changes to improve reliability, serviceability, and the customer experience
- Follow all safety policies and procedures
- Support manufacturing, as needed
- Other duties, as assigned
